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**PROGRAMME NOTE**

The *Wycliffe Carols* tell the story of the nativity by drawing upon very familiar texts from Part 1 of Handel's *Messiah*. Instead of the King James Version of the Bible, however, the carols set the Wycliffe Version of 1395, the oldest complete translation of the Bible into English. This brings about some striking changes to the text; 'Every valley shall be exalted', for example, becomes in this rendering 'Each valley shall be enhaned'. I hope the effect is to defamiliarise these very well-known texts, and through that defamiliarisation to render them freshly vivid and mysterious.

And suddenly there was made with the angel a multitude of heavenly knighthood, hearing God, and saying, Glory be in the highest things to God, and in earth peace be to men of good will.
